

ORDINANCE NO. 946

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY IN BLOCK 29, SPARGO WINTER ADDITION TO THE CITY OF WALSENBURG.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Walsenburg determines and finds that it is in the best interest of the public necessity, health, safety and general welfare to vacate a portion of an alley as specified herein; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Walsenburg further finds that said vacation is not in conflict with appropriate provisions of the City's comprehensive plan; and

WHEREAS, said vacation will not leave any land adjoining the portion of said alley without an established public road, or private-access easement connecting said land with another established public road; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has the authority pursuant to Title 43, Article 2 of the of the Colorado Revised Statutes, as amended, to approve such vacation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WALSENBURG, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:


1. The North/South alleys between Lots 13 through 18, and Lots 19 through 24, in Block 29, Spargo Winter Addition to the City of Walsenburg, be and is hereby vacated.
2. The City hereby finds, determines and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety and the same shall be in full force and effect upon second publication.


